



Safeguarding responsibilities

➤ Schools and their governing boards have a responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of children. This responsibility is outlined in statutory safeguarding guidance, [Keeping Children Safe in Education \(KCSIE\)](#).

Duties

➤ Your governing board must comply with its duties outlined in detail in part 2 of KCSIE, and make sure that policies and procedures in your school are effective and comply with the law at all times.

➤ These duties include:

- Making sure that all staff read at least part 1 of KCSIE
- Making sure that all staff receive regularly updated and appropriate child protection training
- Having policies and procedures in place that support safeguarding, including [child protection](#), [pupil behaviour](#) and [staff behaviour](#) policies
- Making sure that pupils have the opportunity to be taught about safeguarding, including online safety
- Making sure that an appropriate member of staff is appointed as the [designated safeguarding lead \(DSL\)](#)
- Preventing people who pose a risk of harm from working with children by following [safer recruitment procedures](#)

Responsibilities of the safeguarding governor

➤ Your governing board must also appoint a senior board level (or equivalent) lead to take leadership responsibility for your school's/trust's safeguarding arrangements.

➤ Responsibilities of your [senior board level lead](#) include:

- Keeping up to date with statutory guidance and any advice issued by your safeguarding partners/local safeguarding children board
- Making sure you have suitable and up-to-date policies for child protection, staff behaviour/code of conduct, and handling allegations against staff and volunteers
- Supporting the board to develop its understanding of their safeguarding responsibilities, and [report back to the board](#) about safeguarding issues and development
- Meeting regularly with the DSL to monitor policies and procedures, and check that all staff, governors and volunteers have had the appropriate level of training
- [Monitoring the single central record](#) with the DSL to make sure your school carries out [appropriate recruitment checks](#).
